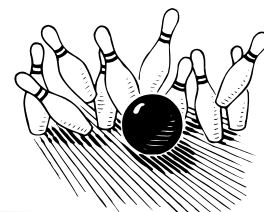
al strikes and picking up some great spares along the way.

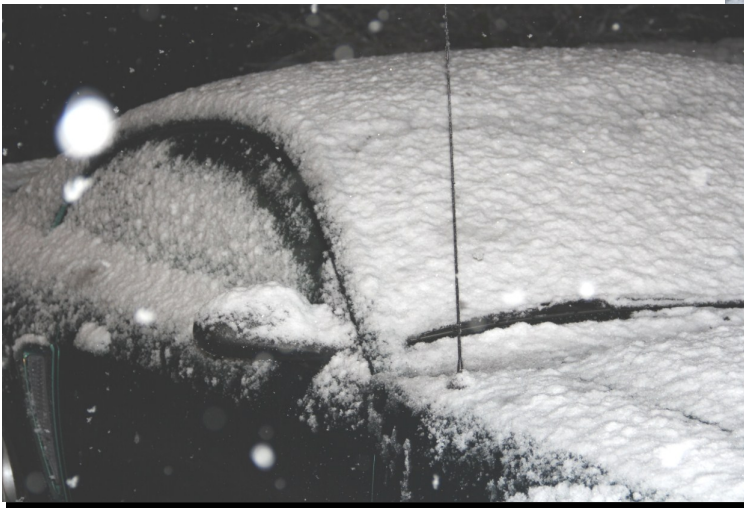
