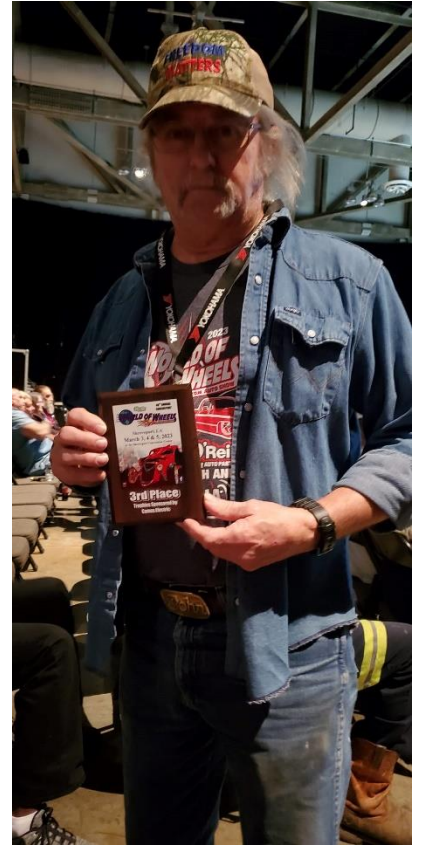

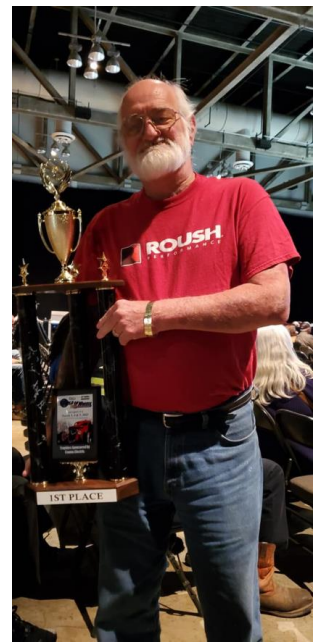

K To continue with our Motor Trend topic about special Fox Body Mustangs, this month is about the 1990 "7-Up Edition Mustang LX".

It's not necessarily the rarest Feature Car that Ford produced ( the 1993 Vibrant White model has that honor), Emerald Green exterior/Oxford White top/Artic White leather interior 'vert has a big following. Thirty of these cars were intended to be promotional car prizes sponsored by the 7-Up Bottling Company--yes, the makers of the popular carbonated beverage. When the program--a half-court-shot contest what would be held during the 1990 NCAA men's college basketball tournament---was scrubbed, Ford released the 7-Up cars as 25th Anniversary Special Editions to dealers for sale to the general public. A total of 4103 7-Up cars were made, 5.0 engines with 4-speed automatics (AOD) or 5-speed (T5) transmissions, 15x7" four-lug aluminum "turbine" wheels, and 3.08 geared Traction-Lok rear axles round out their drivetrains
