FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

At our last board meeting, we discussed the World of Wheels show, and went over in detail the logistics of the show, specifically the man power that we provide in exchange for a large donation. The Board has determined that due to the lack of participation from the membership, we will no longer help supply man power for the World of Wheels show. In other words, 2017 was the last show we will help support.

In going over the signup sheets for 2016 and 2017, about half of the help on most shifts was supplied by non club members that Nicole Ferlito was able to glean from other clubs, and friends of hers that are into the car club scene. This year, over all volunteer numbers were down close to 50 percent per shift. The bottom line is that we have been struggling for the last 2 shows trying to cover all jobs assigned at the show, sacrificing man power to watch our cars in the club display. I decided after tear down at this year's show to present the idea of not providing man power for next year based on positive comments made by several WOW employees about the fantastic job we the Mustang club did. It was at that moment I decided it would be better to get out now on a positive note, rather than wait until we can't provide the manpower and not meet our signed contract terms and consequently shine a negative light on the club.

I brought the issue to the board for a vote, the decision is that we will not host the World of Wheels show for 2018 or any show in the future at this time.

We will however, continue to participate in the Best Club display competition as long as we continue to get volunteer club member cars and ideas for display themes. We already have a theme in mind for 2018, and will start looking for membership cars for the display right after our show in September. Since we will not be hosting the 2018 show we will need club members to volunteer to attend the show during the 3 day weekend to watch over the club display. The club will buy several passes to get members in free to do this and we will ask participants that do not need their second pass to donate them to the club. The board feels we should continue to do this as a show of support for the car club community in our area, and to continue to support World of Wheels.

I want to personally thank all of the core club members, non club member friends, as well as the board of directors that have tirelessly volunteered their weekend free time in the past for World of Wheels, and making our club stand out as a premier club in our community. Thanks also to all past club members who put their cars in our display. Without you we would not have won best club display so many times in the past. Special thanks to Mark and Barbara Winderweedle for supplying a location for building our displays and allowing us back year after year.
