President's Newsletter

The show and shine will be from 1-3pm, then they will cruise as a group to downtown Marshall for the second Saturday Cruise in. I am thinking we could take this a step further, and meet as a club at the Texas welcome center and go to the Jalapeno Tree for lunch before the show and shine to incorporate a lunch cruise to one of my Favorite East Texas restaurants. Stay tuned for emails regarding meeting times and info regarding this show and shine.

As things start to cool off in the fall, there will be other show and shines we can attend as a club to enjoy our rides along with our Mustang and Ford friends.
