# Secretary's Notebook

There Were Bugs Stuck Onto Bugs!

For several months your Secretary has been spending many spare (yet hot) hours under the hood of Sally. Cleaning and repairing damage from the Albuquerque trip have been the order of the day. So many tiny gnats stuck in so many inaccessible places. Unreal.

So, I cleaned. And that unearthed a whole bunch of nicks and pecks in the paint that the buggies left behind.

So, I sanded and repainted. Thank goodness for latex gloves, otherwise I would never get the black engine paint out from under my fingernails.

Then all the cracked paint on the intake manifold jumped up into sight. And who would ever think that gunk and dirt would hide in all those little crevasse in the thing. Why did they design it that way? What is wrong with smooth? AutoZone's Ultimate Cotton Swab Collection, with swabs in at least 10 different sizes, to the rescue!
